Benefits of using SafetyPlan Gold

SafetyPlan Gold differentiates between those elements of the programme developed by the group: “programme”, and those elements that need to be managed locally: “implementation”. The importance of group procedures and systems are thereby recognised, and at the same time, local deviations from these standards are put into sharp focus.

Other features:

- Each element of the programme is given a multiplier to reflect the priority, 0 to 5;
- The audit includes a detailed assessment of documentation;
- Provision has been made to conduct employee and supervisor interviews, and record the results.

The flexibility of the SafetyPlan scoring regime allows an organisation to monitor improvements over time. Achievable targets can be set and improvements recognised.

The ability to modify the priority of each element allows for appropriate weighting on both high and minor risks associated with individual operations and different industries. This allows the scores achieved at each location to be compared with the scores of other locations in the group.

The actions necessary to increase the overall scores, as well as maintain continuous improvement, are documented in the “agreed action plan” section of the report. These actions are outlined in

terms of the action required, by whom, and by when. They can therefore be readily integrated into key performance indicators and management objectives.

The individual criteria have been developed to encompass the requirements of state legislation and the Australian standard on OHS Management Systems – AS 4801.
